

Aims and Scope

The aim of the Asian Pacific Journal of Dentistry is to provide a forum for the publication and rapid dissemination of articles in dentistry. This journal features the following sections, original article, invited review article, short communication, clinical report, and technical article. It allows dentists, dental technicians, dental hygienists, and dental researchers to publish their initial findings, new ideas, clinical experiences, and techniques.

Instructions to Authors

Manuscripts should be submitted by e-mail (docx for the text, xlsx for tables, and jpg, tif, pptx, etc. for the figures) to **the Editor, Asian Pacific Journal of Dentistry, H. Matsumura (matsumura.hideo@nihon-u.ac.jp)**. Submission of a manuscript indicates a tacit understanding that the article is not actively under consideration for publication with another journal. Once a paper is accepted, the authors have transferred the copyright of the article to the *Asian Pacific Journal of Dentistry*. Authors should provide their full address, including the e-mail address, for correspondence. All submitted articles will be acknowledged upon receipt then sent for review. The manuscript, including an abstract (up to 250 words), keywords (up to six), references, tables, figures and figure captions, should be clearly typed in American English. Legible, compact notation should be used, conforming to current practice. Each page of the manuscript should be numbered sequentially.

The manuscript should include the following:

1. Title page: Title (subtitle is not allowed.), name of authors, professional addresses, and e-mail address of the corresponding author.
2. Number of authors: No limit for Original Article. Limit to six or less for Short Communication, Clinical Report, and Technical Article. Statements about equal contributions by two or more authors are not permitted.
3. Abstract: Should be limited to 250 words and typed double-spaced on a separate page. There should be no abbreviations in the abstract. **Abstract section must be structured for all articles except for Short Communication, Clinical Report, and Technical Article.** It should include the 1) Purpose, 2) Material(s) and Method(s), 3) Result(s), 4) Conclusion(s), and 5) Key Words.
4. The text should include 1) Introduction, 2) Materials and Methods (with trade name, manufacturer, manufacturer's city location, country), 3) Results, 4) Discussion, 5) Acknowledgments, and 6) Conflicts of Interest.
5. Text should be limited to 4,000 words for Original Article and Review, whereas 2,000 words for Short Communication, Case Report, and Technical Article.
6. Articles reporting cases require patient or parental consent.
7. The authors must declare that all experiments on human subjects were conducted in accordance with the Declaration of Helsinki (<http://www.wma.net>) and that all procedures were carried out with the adequate understanding and written consent of the subjects. The authors must also certify that formal approval to conduct the experiments described has been obtained from the human subjects review board of their institution and could be provided upon request. The name of IRB and approval code/reference number must be provided in the Materials and Methods section.
8. All animal experiments should be carried out in accordance with institutional and national guidelines for the care and use of experimental animals that are in compliance with the U.K. Animals (Scientific Procedures) Act, 1986 and associated guidelines, the European Communities Council Directive of 24 November 1986 (86/609/EEC) or the National Institutes of Health guide for the care and use of Laboratory animals (NIH Publications No. 8023, revised 1978) and the authors should clearly indicate in the manuscript that such guidelines have been followed. Manuscripts should be accompanied by a statement that all efforts were made to minimize animal suffering, to reduce the number of animals used, and to utilize alternatives to in vivo techniques, if available. The name of IRB and approval code/reference number must be provided in the Materials and Methods section.
9. Tables and figures should also be numbered in the order in which they are cited in the text. Each table and each figure could be edited in the text without a separate page. Color images should be at least 300 DPI. Gray scale images should be at least 300 DPI. Line art (black and white or color) should be at least 1,200 DPI. The cost of color illustrations will be charged to the author.
10. References should be limited to 40 for Original Article, 10 for Short Communication, Case Report, and Technical Article.

(seven authors or more)

List all authors when six or fewer; when seven or more, list first six and add et al.

Articles written in languages other than English should be avoided.

Websites, books, and abstracts cannot be cited in the reference list.

There will be 22,000 JPN yen page charge for APJD members and 33,000 JPN yen page charge (each article) for non-members. An invoice will be issued only for the accepted paper. There is no submission/reviewing charge for the peer review process. Color print and offprint will be prepared on request.

Copyright statement

All manuscripts must be accompanied by the following statement signed by all authors: The undersigned author(s) transfer all copyright ownership of the manuscript (title of the article) to the *Asian Pacific Journal of Dentistry*, in the event the work is published. The undersigned author(s) warrant(s) the article is original, does not infringe upon any copyright or other proprietary right of any third party, is not under consideration for publication by any other journal, and has not been published previously. The author(s) confirm that they have reviewed and approved the final version of the manuscript.
