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- Set the **page size** to A4. Leave 2.5 cm margins on all sides of each page. The preferred font is Times New Roman, 12 points. Do not hyphenate words at the right margin.
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- An **abstract**, no longer than 200 words, is required.
- **Keywords** (about five words) should be listed in alphabetical order immediately below the abstract.
- **Avoid footnotes**. All notes, limited to the minimum necessary, must be arranged in the form of end-of-text notes. They should be consecutively numbered and placed after the main text.
