

# THE JOURNAL OF VETERINARY MEDICAL SCIENCE (JVMS) (Continuation of the Japanese Journal of Veterinary Science)

## —INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS—

1. *Full papers, Notes, and Review articles* that are principally related to veterinary science and are unpublished and not being considered for publication elsewhere are accepted. All manuscripts must be written in correct English. Manuscripts are selected for publication according to an editorial assessment of their suitability and reports from referees. Papers are rejected if ethical guidelines for the care and use of animals have not been adhered to. All animal experiments must have been approved by an appropriate committee of the author's affiliated institution.
  2. If the corresponding author is a member of the Japanese Society of Veterinary Science, the submission charge is ¥10,000 for a *Full paper* or a *Review article* and ¥6,000 for a *Note*. If not, a submission charge of ¥25,000 will be levied for each manuscript. After the paper is accepted, the submission charge is to be paid when requested by the Japanese Society of Veterinary Science (Item 19). A submission charge will not be levied for *Review articles* submitted at the invitation of the Editorial Board.
  3. In the top margin of **the first page** of each paper, one of the following categories should be noted as the field of the paper: *Anatomy, Avian Pathology, Bacteriology, Biochemistry, Clinical Pathology, Ethology, Immunology, Internal Medicine, Laboratory Animal Science, Parasitology, Pathology, Pharmacology, Physiology, Public Health, Surgery, Theriogenology, Toxicology, Virology, and Wildlife Science*. The first page should also include details of the type of paper: *Full paper, Note, or Review article*. In addition, it should include the title, a running head in capital letters and not exceeding 40 letters, authors' names, affiliations and the full address(es) of the institution(s) in which the work was done, as well as the corresponding author name, address, fax number, and e-mail address.
  4. **The second page** should contain the abstract (240 words or less for a *Full paper* or *Review article* and 120 words or less for a *Note*) and up to five key words (in alphabetical order).
  5. **After the second page** of a *Full paper*, the manuscript should be divided into the following sections: INTRODUCTION, MATERIALS AND METHODS, RESULTS, DISCUSSION, ACKNOWLEDGMENTS, REFERENCES, and FIGURE LEGENDS. For a *Note*, such headings are not required, and ACKNOWLEDGMENTS, and REFERENCES should follow the text.
  6. From Vol. 79, No. 1, JVMS became online only with a new one-column layout of full color. **The length of papers**, including Tables, Figures, and any other appendices, should not exceed eight PDF pages for a *Full paper* or *Review article*, and five for a *Note*. One PDF page with no title, tables, or figures, will have about 850 words.
  7. The manuscript should be double spaced (ca. 24–26 lines per page and approx. 70 letters per line) in A4 size (210 × 297 mm) with suitable margins. The main text should be paginated and all lines should be numbered consecutively in the left margin.
  8. Scientific terms for animals, plants, and microorganisms must be italicized.
  9. All abbreviations apart from those listed in Item 10 should be written in parentheses after spelling out the term in full at the first appearance in the manuscript.
  10. Arabic numerals should be used for quantities. Units and abbreviations should conform to the following examples: M, mM,  $\mu$ M, N, %, m, cm, mm,  $\mu$ m, nm, pm, cm<sup>2</sup>, l, ml, kg, g, mg,  $\mu$ g, ng, pg, hr, min, sec, msec, rpm, Hz, Bq, mBq,  $\mu$ Bq, kBq, cpm, dpm, ppm, °C, J, KJ, lux, CPE, LD.
  11. **References** should be arranged in alphabetical order by authors' surname and numbered consecutively. For articles written by the same first author, they should be listed in the following order: (1) article by only the first author, (2) that by the first author + one coauthor, and (3) that by the first author + more than two coauthors. In the text, they should be cited by numbers in square brackets, e.g., [1, 3–5, 7]. The abbreviations of titles of periodicals should conform to ISO 4-1972 (E): Documentation–International Code for the Abbreviation of Titles of Periodicals, and ISO 833-1974 (E): Documentation–International List of Periodical Title Word Abbreviation.

12. In **Tables**, no vertical lines are to be used and each term or phrase should begin with a capital letter. Any explanation essential to the understanding of the Table should be provided as a footnote at the bottom of the Table. Reference to the footnote should be designated by symbols in the order a), b), c).
13. **Articles must be submitted through the electronic submission system (ScholarOne Manuscripts™, hereinafter referred to as S1M).**

Articles should be divided into files as follows and uploaded to the S1M website (<http://mc.manuscriptcentral.com/jvms>). S1M automatically creates a single PDF file from the files uploaded individually. This PDF file is used in the reviewing process. Ensure that there are no garbles and that all images are sharp enough.

The following files should be prepared.

- \* Text of the manuscript: The file should contain all text from the cover page to the references.
  - Manuscripts in Microsoft Word are preferred; Standard fonts (Times New Roman, Century, Helvetica, Arial, and others) should be used.
- \* Figures: Colored figures are welcome. Files should be submitted to S1M in PowerPoint, Word, Excel, Photoshop, (JPEG, TIFF), etc., formats. Note that SHS, EXE, COM, VBS, and ZIP formats will not be accepted.
  - Resolutions: 900–1200 dpi for black and white line art, 600 dpi for color and gray scale and 300 dpi for photograph which contains no text. Please follow the PMC guideline: <https://www.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/pmc/pub/filespec-images/>
- \* Tables: The use of Excel is recommended. Files in PowerPoint are not accepted. The titles of Tables should clearly reflect the contents.

Files should be named as follows.

Text: Author.doc  
 Figure: Author\_Fig1.tif (extension is just an example)  
 Table: Author\_Table1.xls  
 Cover letter: Author\_cov.doc

Figure or table numbers should be contained in the file names.

14. During the submission process, preferred reviewer candidate(s) could be registered.

15. Publication is usually in the order of acceptance after review.
16. For publication, authors will be charged the following fees.
  - (1) A charge for English language revision when deemed necessary by the Editorial Board.
  - (2) Any portion of the text exceeding the length prescribed in Item 6. (¥15,000 per 1 printed page.)
17. The journal is issued monthly.
